We are thrilled to share that for the third year in a row, our friends at **Voya Financial Group** have partnered with us on revitalizing our **Community Garden**. It's a big task and one that this hardworking group enthusiastically requests year after year and we are so happy to have their assistance.

This **team of 24** worked hard to do the work that many find challenging, including: clearing tons of weeds; pruning returning perennials; adding heavy bags of organic soil and fertilizer, planting new seeds & seedlings; decorating and labeling dozens of rocks in English & Spanish for plant identification; assembling plant cages; and, as if that wasn't enough, attaching a privacy screen to our side fencing.

Our **9 raised beds and 12 planter containers** benefited tremendously from their hard work and positive energy.

Following their project, they also enjoyed a delicious lunch on our back picnic tables, next to the garden, prepared by our very own Gather55 restaurant! And in honor of their hard work, financial support and commitment over the years, we were happy to honor them with a **Group Volunteer award**.

We've already started harvesting some produce to support our Community Pantry, Gather55 restaurant, and onsite housing tenants! We are so grateful for Voya's ongoing commitment to support our programs and help us bring **healthy, local, garden-fresh produce** to our Hartford neighbors experiencing food insecurity.
