

Homeless Outreach Case Manager

The Homeless Outreach Case Manager will assess clients, including those who are aged 60 and older with needs related to housing, help individuals find appropriate safe shelter and identify affordable housing opportunities, assist individuals with meeting basic needs, advocate for clients and ensure individuals are successfully linked to resources quickly, provide referrals to support individuals in linking with both formal and informal supports.
