The Homeless Outreach Nurse, will work with individuals experiencing homelessness in the Greater Hartford Area to support optimal health and well-being. This position will promote the well-being of the community and improve the quality of life among people experiencing homelessness. As a priority, the role will engage in activities that will promote, maintain, and improve the health of unhoused individuals, while advocating and providing social support and informal counseling for individuals experiencing homelessness and community health needs. This position will work collaboratively with our outreach team, local municipalities, community agency partners, and contract providers to ensure that they health needs of unhoused individuals are met.
